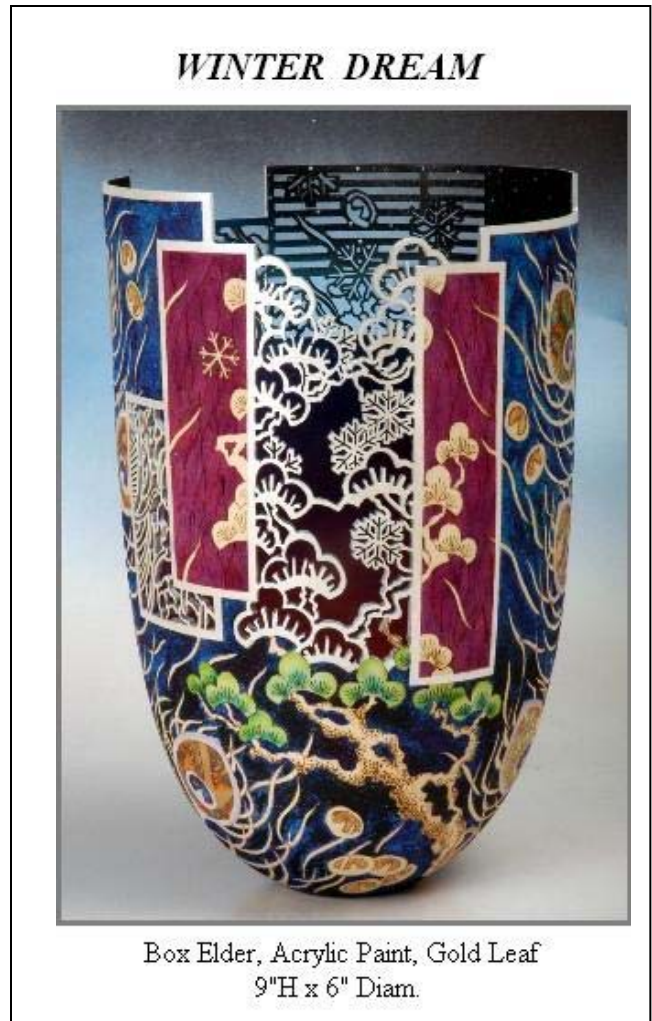
Binh Pho Demonstration
